

First Aid

Medical services are on site at the trade fair center during set up and dismantling, as well as for the duration of the event. First aid points are located at the Entrances West and East, in hall C4 and in the outdoor area north. The first aiders and doctors are on hand to respond to medical emergencies both major and minor, and are supported by the public emergency medical services when

Fire service

In the case of a fire, you must immediately activate the nearest fire alarm (located next to the hall doors and with the emergency telephones in the outdoor exhibition area). The fire services can also be alerted by calling the emergency number 112. Munich's fire services operate a dedicated service at the trade fair center, while fire prevention officials also regularly make the rounds on site.

Security Service

Messe München's security services are on duty at the trade fair grounds 24 hours a day. As well as monitoring the entrances and access routes and keeping an eye on traffic, the security services are also responsible for patrols and general security on the trade fair grounds, documenting accidents and incidents of damage or theft and intervening in the event of security situations and emergencies.

Security staff are coordinated from the security center in the administration building. The site-wide network of security cameras and other technical equipment is also controlled from the security center.

Police

The Munich police force has a strong presence at bauma 2025, with numerous officers stationed in the vicinity and at the trade fair center itself. Among their various tasks, the police are on hand to ensure the security of the event.

Security policy

Working closely with the Munich police force and the relevant officials, Messe München has drawn up a comprehensive security policy for bauma 2025. It sets out who is responsible for security incidents and emergencies, internal and external communication and alarm chains, action plans for a number of different incidents and special safety precautions. These safety precautions include among others:

- an increased presence of both uniformed and non-uniformed security personnel
- the presence of the police in the vicinity of the trade fair and within the grounds
- random bag checks at all entrances using X-ray devices
- the intensification of control measures on access routes
- site-wide video surveillance

Security can react quickly when necessary, adapting or intensifying the safety precautions depending on the situation.

Evacuation and site clearance plan

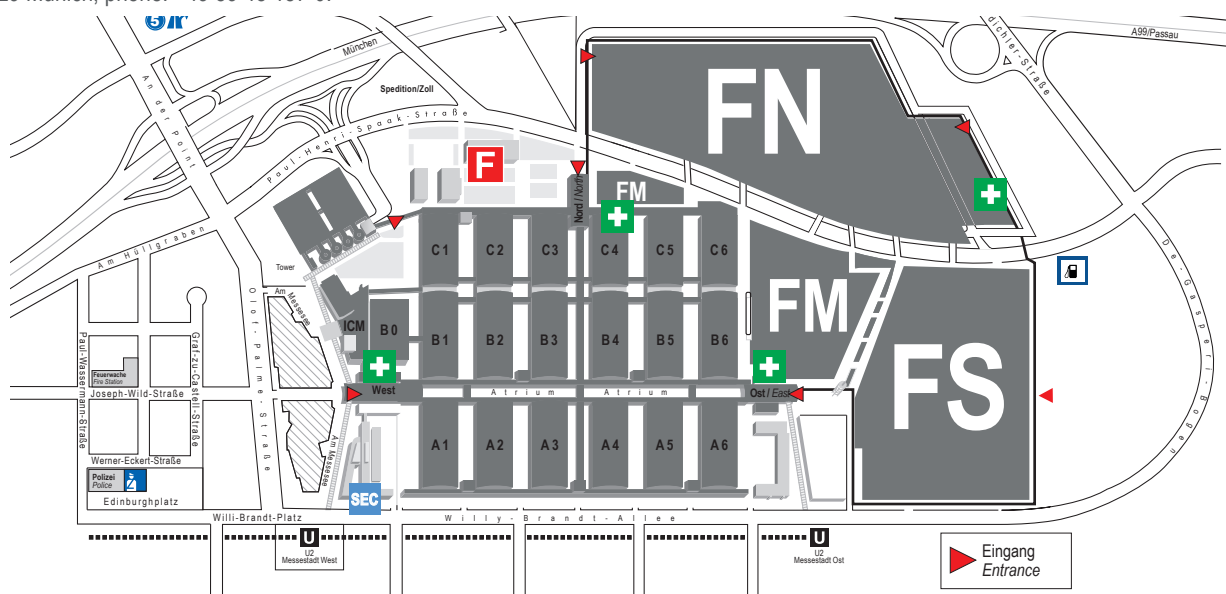
There is a detailed evacuation and site clearance plan in place at the trade fair center. Should evacuation be necessary, exhibitors and visitors will be informed of the situation via a loudspeaker announcement, which will be clearly audible in both the halls and the outdoor exhibition area. In such cases, use the escape routes marked with green signs (generally the hall doors).

Evacuation routes from the halls primarily lead through the loading yards and into a secure, open area. The outdoor exhibition area can be evacuated using any unaffected road. In all cases, please follow the instructions of Messe München security staff members.
