

transport logistic 2025: The international logistics highlight of the year

World's leading trade fair continues to grow

transport logistic 2025 has once again impressively demonstrated its role as an international hub for logistics, mobility, IT, and supply chain management. A record number of 2,719 exhibitors from 73 countries and regions presented their innovations in Munich. The international share was 66 percent, underscoring the global significance of the trade fair. With more than 77,000 trade visitors from over 130 countries and regions and an exhibition area expanded to over 148,000 square meters (2023: 127,000 square meters), the trade fair grew not only in size but also in relevance.

In 2025, air cargo Europe consolidated its position as the leading platform for the air freight industry.

For the first time, it occupied two halls and brought together 346 exhibitors from 53 countries and regions – including numerous airlines, airports, and specialized logistics service providers.






Trend in visitor numbers

Share of international visitors






